Rosenthal, Jason de Lara Molesky, 2023-10-09 Since its emergence in the late twentieth century climate fiction or cli fi has concerned itself as much with economic injustice and popular revolt as with rising seas and soaring temperatures. Indeed with its insistent focus on redressing social disparities cli fi might reasonably be classified as a form of protest literature. As environmental crises escalate and inequality intensifies literary writers and scholars alike have increasingly scrutinized the dual exploitations of the earth's ecosystems and the socioeconomically disadvantaged. Cli Fi and Class focuses on the representation of class dynamics in climate change narratives.
