At the heart of James Coleman's study is the perceived history of the black male in Western culture and the traditional racist stereotypes indigenous to the language. Calibanic discourse Coleman argues so deeply and subconsciously influences the texts of black male writers that they are unable to cast off the oppression inherent in this discourse.
